

## Week #33 Triangles



The sweater is knit all in one piece with no seaming. It is made using only 3 double pointed needles. . You knit in the round as you would with 4 or 5 needles but it is so much less awkward on such a tiny garment. Sweater is approx. 3" tall

### Materials:

Size 2 Double pointed needles (set of 3)

Sport Weight, dk, lace or DMC #5 pearl cotton weight yarn. 25 yards of main color. 5 yards of contrast color for Triangles on front of sweater and sleeves. Lines from Triangle are embroidered after sweater is knit.

Variegated yarn used in sample is from EvilEnabler on Etsy.

miniature doll coat hanger or Large paper clip to make your own coat hanger.

large darning needle

### Abbreviations:

st= stitch

pm= place marker

sm = slip marker

inc.= increase. Increases are made by knitting in front and back of stitch.

k= knit

p= purl

st st = stockinette stitch

MC = Main Color

CC = Contrast Colorw

With main color cast on 36 stitches and divide onto 2 needles, 18sts on first needle (front of sweater) , 18 sts on second needle (back of sweater)

Join, knitting in the round on 2 needles, using a 3rd needle to knit the stitches.

Rounds 1-2: with main color, p1, k1 across

Rounds 3-4: knit



## Sleeves

Pick up 15 sts around arm hole, starting at underarm and divide onto 2 needles. Join:

Round 1: K4 MC, K7 CC, K4 MC

Round 2: K5 MC, K5 CC, K5 MC

Round 3: K 6 MC, K3, CC, K6 MC

Round 4: K7 MC, K1, CCK7 MC

Rounds 5-10: K 15 MC

Next 2 rounds: K1, P1 around

Bind off all stitches in ribbing and repeat for second sleeve.

## Finishing:

Weave in all ends and stitch up any holes under the armhole. Embroider lines using contrast color and running stitch as shown in picture. Add miniature coat hanger and hang on tree.
